Focus on Pembrokeshire



After what has seemed an eternity, we are at last hearing positive news on the fight against the pandemic.

Hywel Dda Community Health Council, Pembrokeshire locality members, have risen to the challenge of changing the way we work.

During 2019/2020 (up until the pandemic) Hywel Dda CHC members visited 27 NHS sites in the three counties, 10 within Pembrokeshire, these included:

- Neyland Health Centre
- A&E Department, Withybush Hospital
- Women and children's services, Withybush Hospital

We have asked people their views on services such as Mental Health, Orthodontics (we had a great response from the young people of Pembrokeshire) and Experience of NHS services during the pandemic. At our meetings with the Health Board we continue to raise your concerns on issues such as:

- Pembrokeshire Mental & Learning Disability services
- Frailty & Surgical Unit
- Routine NHS dental treatment.

Going forward we are looking into using iPads to speak with people on the wards, by doing this we will not have to enter the hospitals

We will continue to represent our communities, as the watchdog of the NHS to make sure your voice is included in the design and delivery of NHS services locally.

Just a part of what we do : Have you got a Dentist? April 2021

During the pandemic we have heard from people about the worries they had about their dental care. Like many services, dental practices had to think about the safety of their staff and patients.

This meant that people could no longer go to their dentist for routine appointments and although there was emergency care available, this was not always what people needed.

Instead, people went without check-ups or basic dental treatment such as fillings, or denture repairs for many months. Other people who wanted to register with a dentist, found that they were unable to do so.

The CHC undertook a 'mystery shopper' exercise across the three counties of Hywel Dda in order to see what dental services were like. This is what people told us:
