

# How to join the National Databank



Good Things Foundation has developed the UK National Databank to help thousands of vulnerable people to get connected, giving community groups access to free data – either via SIM cards or vouchers – that they can share with digitally excluded people, as well as support.

## Who can join?

Community organisations can join the National Databank if they directly support people who are experiencing data poverty, have the capacity to support people activating and starting to use their data **and** can provide their registered company or charity number.

## Eligibility criteria

Community organisations can gift data to people who are 18+ years old **AND** from a low income household . They must also qualify in one or more of the following statements:

- Have no or insufficient access to the internet at home
- **AND/OR** have no or insufficient access to the internet away from the home
- **AND/OR** cannot afford their monthly contract or top up
