REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY ACTIVITIES IN CARMARTHEN

Remembrance Sunday activities were different in Carmarthen last year due to the restrictions associated with Covid 19. However, this year it is hoped that there will be more of a sense of normality to the Parade and Service which will be held on Sunday, 14th November and it is very much hoped that the public will be able to support the same.

The itinerary for this year is as follows:

9.15 a.m. Participants of the parade will assemble in front of the Guildhall, Guildhall Square.

9.30 a.m. The Parade will move off towards St Peter's Church via St Peter's Civic Hall.

10.00 a.m. The Service will commence at St Peter's Church. Please note that the number of attendees inside the Church will be limited due to the ongoing Coronavirus.

11.00 a.m. Following the Church Service there will be a short service with the laying of the wreaths at the County War memorial in Priory Street when the two minute silence will be observed.

12.00 mid-day The Parade will have marched back to Guildhall Square and thereafter be dismissed by the Mayor.
