Three boys have been formally warned by police about their behaviour following a spate of criminal damage caused to property at Carmarthen Park.

The three boys - who attend schools in Carmarthen but cannot be named due to legal reasons - have all written personal letters to the Town Council apologising for their behaviour.

The Mayor of Carmarthen Cllr Gareth John said: “Hopefully this will bring an end to the bad behaviour of a minority of young people that has unfortunately blighted people’s experience of using Carmarthen Park during the summer. I would like to thank the local policing team for taking this course of action and I hope that this will deter children and young people from committing offences in Carmarthen and to respect other families using the Park”.

The Town Council has spent over £150,000 this year upgrading the play areas and making other improvements to Carmarthen Park.
