#### Agenda Item 4(a): Planning Applications

- (i) **PL/04573** - Proposal to install 6no. Flogas Tanks to supply Glangwili General Hospital with LPG gas and re-instate lost car parking to Day Nursery Car Park. Overall scheme will work towards reducing emissions in working towards net zero carbon agenda - Glangwili General Hospital, Dolgwili Road, Carmarthen, SA31 2AF
- (ii) **PL/04749** - Provision of secure storage containers to the east of the stores building. The containers are to house materials and equipment in support of the local telecoms infrastructure network. The Government has set a target to connect a minimum of 85% of premises to gigabit-capable coverage by 2025. The use of storage container allows the client to move and flex at relatively short notice and low cost to suit areas which require the teams - British Telecom Tec Depot, Dolgwili Road, Carmarthen, SA31 2AQ
