132. Apologies

Apologies for absence were received from Cllrs Arwel Lloyd, Phil Grice, Dr Baba Gana, Barry Williams and Miriam Moules.

133. Declarations of Interest

Cllr Alun Lenny declared an interest in Agenda item 4(a) as Chair of the County Council Planning Committee.

Cllr Emlyn Schiavone declared an interest in Agenda item 4(a) as an acquaintance of the applicant.

134. Matters arising from minutes of the previous General Purposes Committee Meeting

135. Planning Applications

W/37755 – 21 Heol Morfa Brenin, Carmarthen – No Objections

The Clerk advised that the Planning Appeal in relation to Cartref Tawelan had been upheld by the Planning Inspectorate Wales.

138. Lift at St Peter's Civic Hall

It was proposed by Cllr Peter Hughes Griffiths, seconded by Cllr Angharad Jones Leefe and agreed by all that a **RECOMMENDATION** be made to Council to seek quotes for the work on a new stair lift to the Hall (to replace the broken stair lift), and revisit the issue of a shaft lift to the Hall after the installation of the stair lift.

139. LINC Project – Integrated Transport Network Survey – Carmarthenshire County Council.

It was proposed by Cllr Angharad Jones Leefe seconded by Cllr Alun Lenny, and **AGREED** by all that a link for the survey should be circulated to all members to complete the survey individually.

140. Town Council IT Systems & Support for the Introduction of Carmarthen Town Council Email addresses for Members

It was proposed by Cllr Peter Hughes Griffiths, seconded by Cllr Alun Lenny and agreed by all that a **RECOMMENDATION** be made to Council that Carmarthen Town Council should provide email addresses for all Councillors via Office 365 with the domain name .cymru.

141. The County War Memorial at Priory Street

It was proposed by Cllr Alun Lenny, seconded by Cllr Peter Hughes Griffiths and agreed by all that a **RECOMMENDATION** be made to Council that Carmarthen Town Council should clean the War Memorial after seeking guidance from CCC on this matter.

142. Commonwealth War Graves Commission

It was proposed by Cllr Alun Lenny, seconded by Cllr Peter Hughes Griffiths and agreed by all that a **RECOMMENDATION** be made to Council that Carmarthen Town Council should place the requested sign at the Town Cemetery.

143. Standing Orders and a Town Council Constitution

It was proposed by Cllr Peter Hughes Griffiths, seconded by Cllr Alun Lenny and agreed by all that a **RECOMMENDATION** be made to Council that the Standing Orders and Constitution should be adopted bar item 13.7 which the Committee agreed should be subject to a vote at Full Council.

144. Security at Five Fields Allotments

It was proposed by Cllr Emlyn Schiavone, seconded by Cllr Peter Hughes Griffiths and agreed by all that a **RECOMMENDATION** be made to Council that

Option 3 should be accepted . *'Providing a more effective security fence for the existing public footpath through the middle of the allotments - Carmarthenshire County Council has offered to provide this security fencing free of charge (as part of the Wetlands Development Project) in return for the Town Council agreeing to take over the maintenance of the Wetlands, including the public footpaths forming part or travelling through it.'*

145. Supporting and Promoting the Welsh Language : An inquiry into the legislative, policy and wider context

It was proposed by Cllr Alun Lenny, seconded by Cllr Emlyn Schiavone and agreed by all that a **RECOMMENDATION** be made to Council that the following submissions should be made to the enquiry -

1. We welcome the fact that this research looks at international practice to try and promote the language;
2. It is important to ensure the honesty or integrity of the new body by responding objectively and with neutrality in the role;
3. There is a need for a clear and unambiguous definition of the word 'serious' in relation to complaints to the body;
4. Carmarthen Town Council is keen to ensure that the new measures are stronger than the powers of the Language Commissioner - these weaknesses have been the subject of frustration in the past;
5. . The measure should be relevant to the private sector, as well as the public sector, in order to encourage the use of the language in the private sector.
